## SLIPSTREAM BRAKE PEDAL PAD KIT

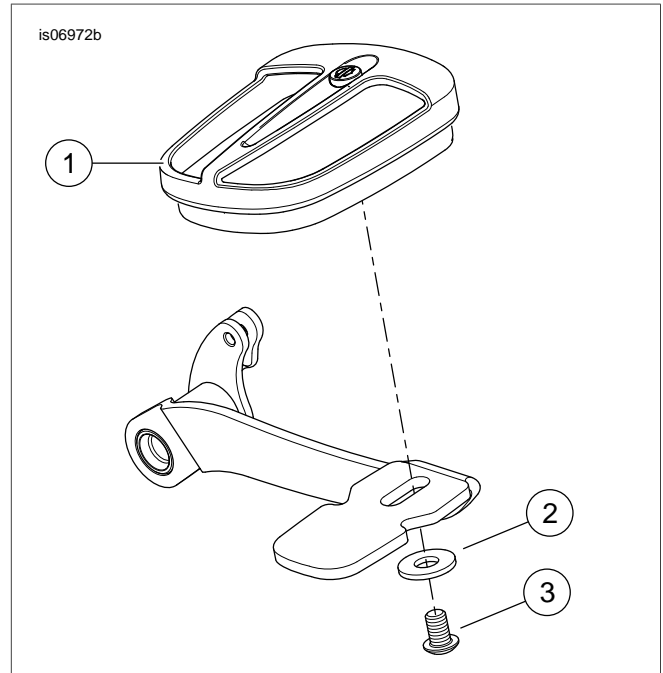


Figure 1. Slipstream Brake Pedal Kit Contents

### INSTALLATION

1. Remove and discard the previously installed brake pedal cover from the foot brake lever.
2. Align the brake pedal assembly (2) over the lever as shown. Insert the button fastener (1) into the brake pedal assembly, assemble the washer (3), screw (4) and thread the screw through the hole in the brake lever and into the back of the pad.
3. Tighten the screw to 10 ft-lbs (13.5 Nm).

### WARNING

After repairing the brake system, test brakes at low speed. If brakes are not operating properly, testing at high speeds can cause loss of control, which could result in death or serious injury. (00289a)
