REMOVAL

- See Figure 1. Loosen but do not remove three screws (2) (with flat washers) securing the windshield to the fairing (1).
- 2. Raise and remove the windshield.

INSTALLATION

- 1. See Figure 1. Place the windshield into position between the inner and outer fairings (1) engaging the slotted holes in the windshield with the threaded bosses on the inner fairing.
- 2. Tighten three screws (2) to 25-30 in-lbs (2.8-3.4 Nm).

CARE AND CLEANING

NOTICE

Polycarbonate windscreens/windshields require proper attention and care to maintain. Failure to maintain polycarbonate properly can result in damage to the windscreen/windshield. (00483d)

- Do not use benzene, paint thinner, gasoline or any other type of harsh cleaner on the windscreen/windshield. Doing so will damage the surface.
- Do not clean polycarbonate in hot sun or high temperature.
- Powdered, abrasive or alkaline cleanser will damage the windscreen/windshield.
- Sunlight reflections off of the inside curvature of a windscreen/windshield can, at certain times of the

day, cause extreme heat build-up on motorcycle instruments. Exercise care in parking. Park facing the sun, place an opaque object over the instruments, or adjust the windscreen/windshield to avoid reflections.

• Do not use benzene, paint thinner, gasoline or any other cleaning agents on the rubber bushings. Doing so will damage the bushing surfaces.

NOTE

Harley-Davidson Windshield Water Repellent Treatment part number 99841-01 is approved for use on Harley-Davidson polycarbonate windshields.
