- **STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition. Let motorcycle cool.
- **NOTICE** A FACTORY SERVICE MANUAL MAY BE HELPFUL IN PERFORMING THIS INSTALLATION. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PERFORM THIS INSTALLATION IF YOU ARE NOT CONFIDENT IN YOUR ABILITY TO COMPLETE ALL OF THE STEPS IN THE PROCEDURE; CONSULT A TRAINED TECHNICIAN.
- **STEP 2** Refer to PIC 1. Starting on the left (clutch) side, remove the upper and lower front caliper mounting screws. Set screws aside, they will be reused.
- **STEP 3** For motorcycles equipped with ABS: Carefully cut the cable straps that connect the front wheel speed sensor (WSS) cable to the brake line or the fender tip lamp cable.


Release sensor cable from caliper bracket.

Note: Refer to your motorcycle's service manual for assistance.

OPTION 1: LEFT (CLUTCH) SIDE INSTALLATION

STEP 4 Refer to PIC 2 and 3. Locate the provided Left Caliper Cover, and the two (2) screws that were removed in Step 2. Align the mounting holes of the cover with the left fork leg mounting holes. Be sure the sensor wire is positioned behind the caliper cover and not kinked or pinched by any parts. Insert the screws through the mounting holes and lightly tighten them. Check the bottom of the caliper cover to make sure you have clearance from the brake rotor and tire valve stem and verify the WSS cable moves freely. Fully tighten screws.



STEP 5

Secure the WSS cable to the brake line, or to the front fender tip lamp wires. Be sure the sensor cable is not kinked, pinched, or comes in contact with operating parts that could damage the wire.

OPTION 2: LEFT (CLUTCH) SIDE INSTALLATION

STEP 6 Refer to PIC 5. Locate the ABS retaining clip and bracket. Turn the bracket upside-down so that it's embossed. Install the ABS clip in the reverse order from how it was dissembled.

Note: Refer to your motorcycle's service manual for assistance.

STEP 7 Locate the provided Left Caliper Cover, and the two (2) screws that were removed in Step 2. Align the mounting holes of the sensor bracket, the caliper cover, and the left fork leg. Insert the screws through the mounting holes and lightly tighten them. Check the bottom of the caliper cover to make sure you have clearance from the brake rotor and tire valve stem. Fully tighten screws.

TORQUE VALUE FOR MOUNTING SCREWS: 28-38 FT-LB (37.9-51.5 NM)

STEP 8 Secure the WSS cable to the brake line, or to the front fender tip lamp wires. Be sure the sensor cable is not kinked, pinched, or comes in contact with operating parts that could damage the wire.

RIGHT (BRAKE) SIDE INSTALLATION

- **STEP 9** Remove the upper and lower front caliper mounting screws. Set screws aside, they will be reused.
- **STEP 10** Refer to PIC 6. Locate the provided Left Caliper Cover, and the two (2) screws that were removed in Step 2. Align the mounting holes of the caliper cover and the left fork leg. Insert the screws through the mounting holes and lightly tighten them. Check the bottom of the caliper cover to make sure you have clearance from the brake rotor and tire valve stem. Tighten the bolts to the factory torque specs.
