#### INSTALLATION

# Remove Original Equipment (OE) Exhaust Shields

- 1. Allow the motorcycle to cool.
- 2. Record the position of the OE band clamp screws securing the exhaust shields to the exhaust pipes.




Figure 1. Service Parts: Exhaust Shield Kit

- 3. See Figure 1. Loosen intermediate shield (A) clamps (B).
- Open the five band clamps (C) Securing the front and rear shields. Spread the bands and remove exhaust shields from the exhaust.
- 5. Transfer the band clamps (C) to the **new** exhaust shields (1, 2) in the orientation recorded during removal.

#### Install New Exhaust Shields

- See Figure 1. Install the shields on the exhaust pipes.
   Tighten the band clamps enough to hold the exhaust shields in place.
- Adjust the shields and band clamps to avoid contact with other components.
- 3. Tighten all clamp screws.

## NOTICE

Wipe all fingerprints off of exhaust system components after installation and before starting engine. Oil from hands can leave permanent marks on exhaust system finish. (00346a)

4. Wipe off all fingerprints. Oil from hands will burn permanently into finish.
