**STEP 1** Read and understand all steps in the instructions before starting the installation. Park the motorcycle on a hard, level surface and turn off the ignition.

**STEP 2** Remove the saddlebags and set them out of the way on a soft and clean cloth so they will not be scratched or damaged.

**STEP 3** Remove the radio antenna from the motorcycle to ease the installation of the rack.

# NOTE STEP 4, STEP 5 & STEP 6 ARE ONLY FOR INSTALLATION ON ROAD KINGS, ROAD GLIDES, OR FLHT STANDARD.

**STEP 4** Remove the license plate and mounting bracket from the support bar. License plate will need to be relocated using Küryakyn P/N 2098 (not included) or similar license plate relocating product.



ATTENTION! Ensure the area of installation is free of grease, oil, dirt or other debris to ensure proper adhesion. Küryakyn WILL NOT warranty any parts lost due to improper installation.

ATTENTION! The adhesive will not bond correctly if applied at temperatures less than 50°F.

Do not attempt this installation in temperatures less than 50°F.

**STEP 6** Using the back of your fingernail, rub the backing of the adhesive pad in the hole cap to activate the catalyst. Remove the backing from the adhesive pad and place the cap over one of the mounting holes on the support bar. (See <u>PIC.1</u>.) Repeat this process for the other hole cap.

**STEP 7** The luggage rack offers two different mounting positions, however we recommend the forward position as indicated by the circles in <u>PIC.2</u>. The other mounting position can be used if there is not proper clearance between the seat, sissy bar or any other installed accessories.

**STEP 8** Loosely install the mounting brackets as shown in  $\underline{PIC.3}$ , using the 10-24 x 3/4 BSCS screws and #10 lock washers from the hardware kit. Place the lock washer and the screw in the mount clamp and thread into the rack.

**NOTE** Do not fully tighten the screws securing the clamps to the rack, as they need to be left loose to achieve proper alignment.

**STEP 9** Place the rack on the support bar and determine proper spacing for mounting clamps. Also, check for clearance between the rack and the seat, sissy bar or any other installed accessories.

**STEP 10** Make sure the rack is straight on the bike.

**STEP 11** Once placement of the clamps has been determined, snug the screws holding the clamps to the rack.

**STEP 12** Remove the rack and tighten all of the screws that secure the placement clamps to the rack.

**STEP 13** Hold the rack upside down, off to one side of the support bar, place the

bottom half of the clamp assembly on the clamp-mounting arm over the support bar, and start a 1/4"- $20 \times 3/4$ " SHCS screw from the hardware kit. (See <u>PIC.4</u>.)

**STEP 14** Rotate the rack into place on the support bar; making sure that the rack is properly positioned so that all the clamps are resting evenly on the support bar.

**STEP 15** Install the remaining two bottom clamp halves to the clamp mounting arms using the 3/4 SHCS screws from the hardware kit.

**STEP 16** Tighten all fasteners and verify that there is proper clearance.

**STEP 17** Reinstall the radio antenna and saddlebags.
