DYNA GLIDE SLIP-ON ACCESSORY MUFFLERS

General

The following slip-on mufflers are designed to fit 1995 and later Dyna Glide model motorcycles:

80104-99 (Slash out, chrome) 80313-99 (Slash out, black) 80316-99 (Slash down, black) 80366-99 (Slash down, chrome)

Kit contents:

- <u>Qty</u> **Description**
- Rear muffler 1
- Front muffler 1
- 2 Muffler clamps

Not legal for sale or use in California on pollutioncontrolled vehicles.

Installation

- 1. Loosen stock muffler clamps and remove nuts that attach mufflers to muffler support tube. Remove stock mufflers. Save all mounting hardware for reinstallation.
- 2. Install new kit mufflers using muffler clamps from kit and stock mounting hardware saved from step 2. Do not tighten hardware at this time.

NOTE

Before tightening nuts that attach mufflers to muffler support tubes, make sure the front muffler is positioned as far forward in its brackets slot as possible. This will eliminate any possible contact between the mufflers.

Tighten muffler clamp bolts to 45-60 ft-lbs (61-81 Nm). 3. Tighten nuts that attach mufflers to muffler support tube snugly.

NOTE

Due to the increased diameter of these mufflers (as compared with original equipment), some realignment of headpipes is usually required. It is recommended to replace exhaust port gaskets, Part Number 65324-83A, to avoid the tendency of headpipes to return to original position when retightened.

Noise Emission Warranty

Gabilan Manufacturing, Inc. warrants that these mufflers, at the time of sale, meet all applicable United States E.P.A. Federal noise standards. This warranty extends to the first person who buys these mufflers for purposes other than resale, and to all subsequent buyers. Warranty claims should be directed to an authorized Harley-Davidson Dealer.

Tampering Prohibition

Federal law prohibits any modification to this exhaust system which causes the motorcycle to exceed the Federal noise standard. Use of the motorcycle with such a modified exhaust system is also prohibited.

This product should be checked for repair or replacement if the motorcycle noise has increased significantly through use. Otherwise, the owner may become subject to penalties under state and local ordinances.
